JFS Food Delivery Guidelines

JFS Volunteers are pivotal in ensuring food is distributed to community members facing food insecurity. Last year, JFS volunteers helped deliver over 21,500 meals to JFS clients in need! With your help, JFS continues to support our community for years to come. See below for general food delivery guidelines and thank you for your service!

- Food delivery days are every Friday of the month.
 - Twice a month, many clients also receive kosher-style Shabbat
 Mitzvah Meals prepared by Kaplan Catering.
 - Shabbat Mitzvah Meals are distributed at Kaplan Catering (9420 Forum Dr. Ste. 111, Raleigh- behind the new Target store)

- All food pick-up and delivery is curbside.
- JFS Volunteers can sign up to deliver through Sign-Up Genius. Links are made available monthly via multiple communication and sign ups need to be entered before Wednesday at noon that week.
- JFS Volunteers receive pick-up and delivery location information the week via email from the JFS Volunteer Coordinator (VC). If you do not receive an email with this information, you are not scheduled to deliver.

Before you deliver, please familiarize yourself with the following guidelines:

- ✓ When you arrive please do not park or exit your vehicle, a JFS staff member or volunteer will gather your deliveries and place them inside your vehicle.
- ✓ Please let the VC know ASAP if you are unable to deliver. If you do not feel well or have a fever or have been in contact with someone who has symptoms, DO NOT VOLUNTEER! Your health and safety are more important!
- ✓ All volunteers must wear MASKS when delivering items to client's doorsteps. These can be provided, if requested at time of pick-up.
